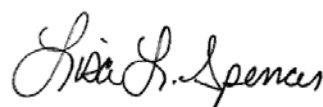

MAKING A REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION DONATION TO ANDERSON HOSPITAL FOUNDATION

Is donating IRA funds to a charity tax deductible?

As Anderson Hospital Foundation is a 501c3 organization, any contributions made to them are exempt from income tax. Donating part or all your unused retirement assets, such as your individual retirement account (IRA), is an excellent way to contribute to a charity like Anderson Hospital Foundation while avoiding tax on the payout of the asset.

How does a qualified charitable distribution work?

If you are over age 70½, you may give a gift from your IRA as a tax-free distribution to a qualified charity. An amount (up to \$100,000 annually) transferred from your IRA directly to Anderson Hospital Foundation can meet your required minimum distribution without being considered taxable income. The distribution, also known as an IRA Charitable Rollover, is authorized by Section 408(d)(8) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Can a charity like Anderson Hospital Foundation be the beneficiary of my IRA?

A beneficiary can be any person or entity, such as Anderson Hospital Foundation, the owner chooses to receive the benefits of a retirement account or an IRA after the owner's lifetime. Make your IRA part of your legacy

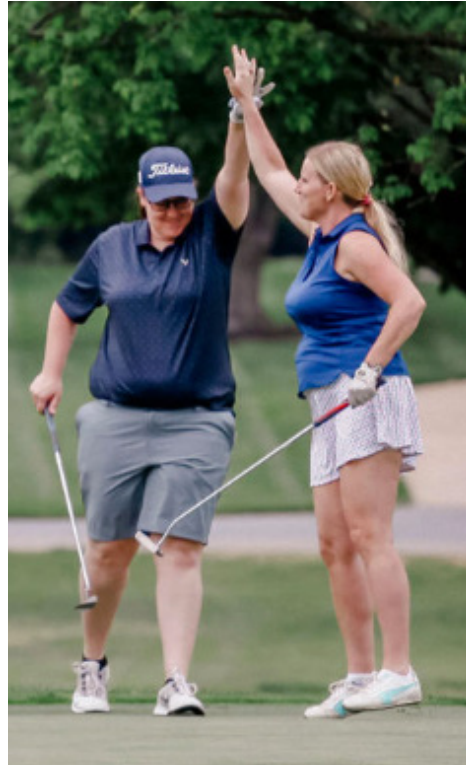
