National Recognition

We are proud to share that Anderson Hospital has once again been recognized by Newsweek as one of the World's Best Hospitals for 2025!

This marks the fourth consecutive year we have earned this incredible honor. This prestigious recognition places Anderson Hospital among the top 4% of hospitals in the United States. Out of 410 U.S. hospitals named to the list, Anderson ranked at #250. Even more impressively, of the 230 hospitals in Illinois, only twenty-one made the list, and Anderson Hospital is one of them!

Entering a New "ERa" in Emergency Care

Just as Taylor Swift's celebrated "Eras Tour" marked a journey of transformation, we too are entering a new ERa at Anderson Hospital. Our

Emergency Department expansion represents one of the most significant projects in our hospital's history. One that will enhance access, capacity, and the patient experience for years to come.

As we began the silent phase of a Capital Campaign to support the project, we are extremely grateful to the generous donors' remarkable gifts. Their contribution is a powerful testament to the spirit of philanthropy that continues to shape Anderson's future.

Each update brings us one step closer to opening the doors of a modern, expanded Emergency Department designed to meet the evolving needs of Madison County and beyond.

Investing in the Future Healthcare Workforce

This year, we deepened our longstanding partnership with Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE) School of Nursing. This provided more opportunities to work closely with the SIUE School of Nursing to focus on the formation of an innovative and collaborative clinical partnership program to advance nursing education and workforce development in this region. As a proud two-time SIUE School of Nursing alumnus, I find this

collaboration deeply personal. Together, we are helping ensure that students graduate prepared to deliver the exceptional care our region deserves.

We also took meaningful steps to expand educational opportunities for young people pursuing careers in healthcare. Anderson Healthcare proudly announced its sponsorship of the Clinical Health Occupations (CNA) program at the Collinsville Area Vocational Center (CAVC). 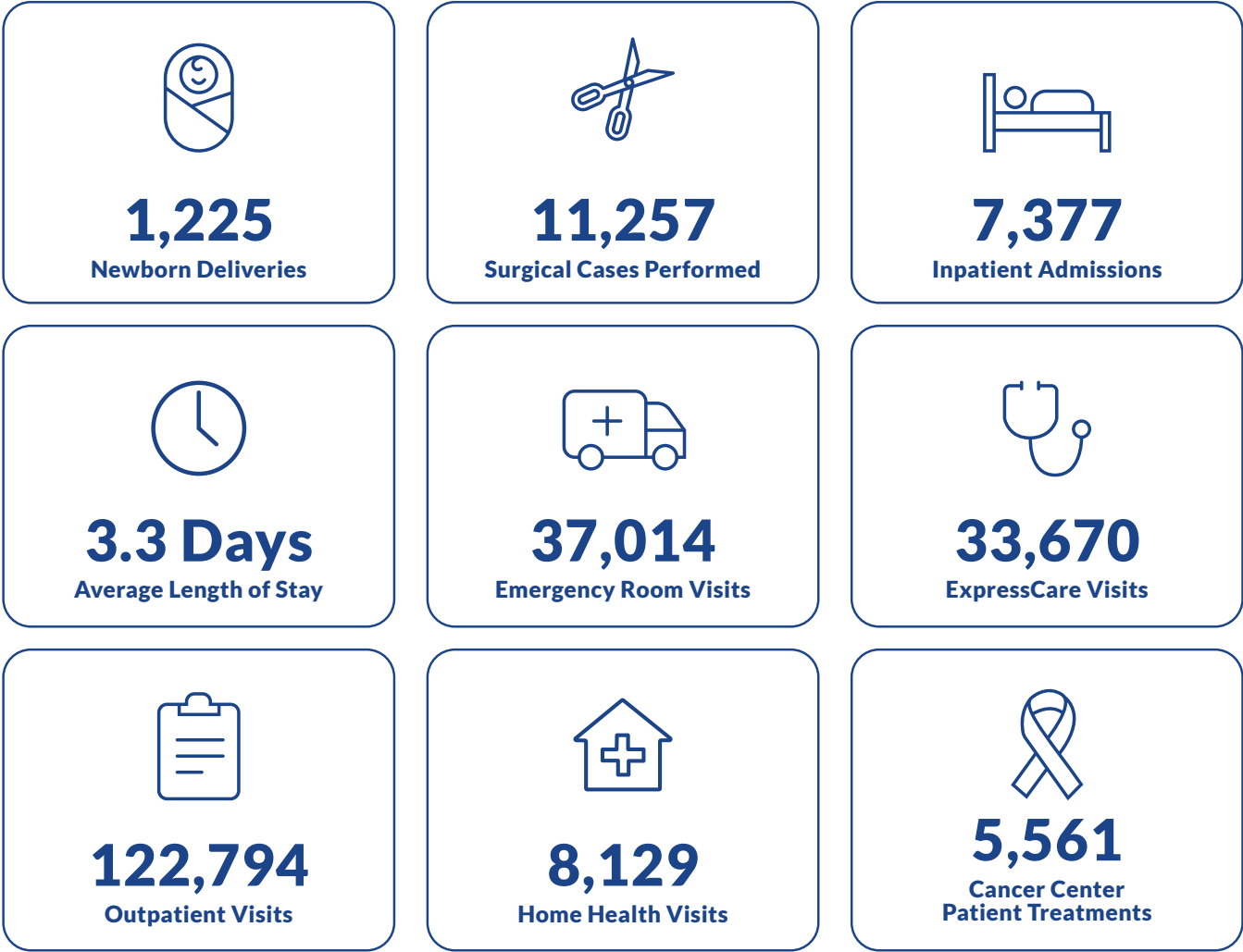
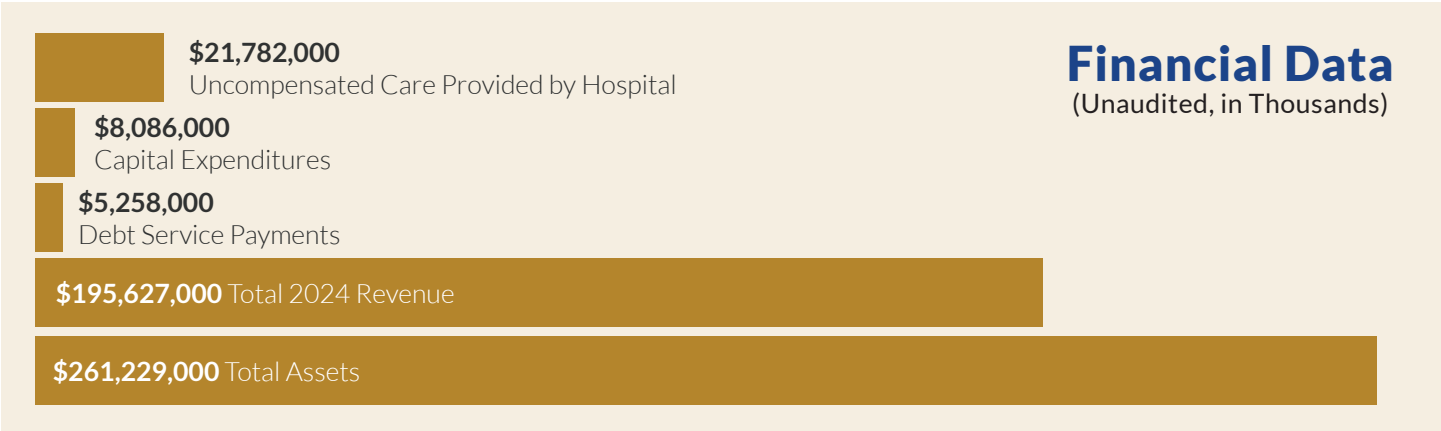

Memorials and Tributes

Many people consider giving a gift in memory or in honor of a loved one a thoughtful gesture. Regardless of the amount, such gifts are a fitting way to acknowledge someone's life, a relative's or friend's birthday, or other special occasion. When you make a donation, the recipient will be notified, or in the case of a memorial, the immediate family will receive a notification along with the donor. The Foundation's Annual Report will recognize the memorials for an individual, along with the donors who contributed. Similarly, tributes will receive the same recognition.



Planned Giving and Bequest

By engaging in long-term estate and financial planning, you can significantly benefit Anderson Hospital while also achieving your personal financial objectives. Donating a planned gift not only shows your concern for the current state of healthcare but also creates a lasting legacy for future generations. Since Anderson Hospital Foundation is a non-profit entity, most donations are eligible for federal and state income tax deductions. We encourage you to discuss potential tax advantages with your advisor.



Matching Gifts

Did you know that your company may match your donation? You can check with your human resources department to see if they have a matching gift policy. If they do, they'll provide you with a form to fill out and send to us along with your donation. After we've verified your gift, either online or by mail, your company will send a matching gift contribution to Anderson Hospital Foundation. Sometimes, companies will even double or triple the amount you donate!



Making a Required Minimum Distribution

As Anderson Hospital Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization, any contributions made to it are exempt from income tax. Donating part or all of your unused retirement assets, such as your individual retirement account (IRA), is an excellent way to contribute to a charity like Anderson Hospital Foundation while avoiding tax on the payout of the asset.

If you are over age 70 ½, you may give a gift from your IRA as a tax-free distribution to a qualified charity. An amount (up to \$100,000 annually) transferred from your IRA directly to Anderson Hospital Foundation can meet your required minimum distribution without being considered taxable income. The distribution, also known as an IRA Charitable Rollover, is authorized by Section 408(d)(8) of the Internal Revenue Code.

A beneficiary can be any person or entity, such as Anderson Hospital Foundation. The owner chooses to receive the benefits of a retirement account or an IRA after the owner's lifetime. Make your IRA part of your legacy. As always, please consult your advisor to determine if this type of gift is right for you.
